# **MEREWAY FISH PASS**

### **Frequently Asked Questions**

What is Mereway Weir? Mereway Weir is an automatic tilting weir on the River Crane, designed to maintain flows for the Duke of Northumberland's River and the River Crane.

What does it do? It keeps a steady flow into the River Crane and into the Duke of Northumberland and is a key flood defence asset for the Twickenham area, when flows are higher from rain.

Why has the weir been replaced? The previous weir was at the end of its lifespan, including the parts that operate it. A new weir and operating systems have been installed.

Why is a fish pass needed? A fish pass is beneficial as the weir currently acts as a barrier to migrating fish from the Crane, Duke of Northumberland and Tidal Thames.

**How will this benefit me?** The weir protects over 500 residential properties from a high-risk flood event. The weir continues this protection. The fish pass will link the Duke of Northumberland and the River Crane, increasing the number of fish seen upstream.
